- It is unfair to underfund schools in low-income neighborhoods.

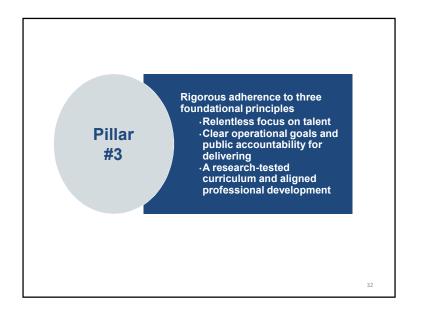

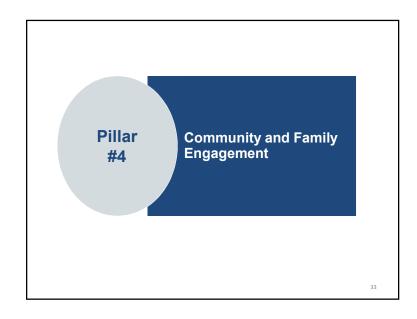
- 1. A Shared Sense of Urgency and Commitment

- 3. Rigorous Adherence to Three Foundational Principles

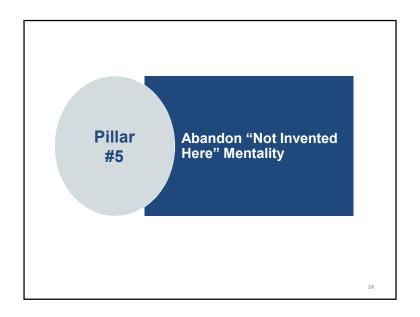
 - Relentless Focus on Talent

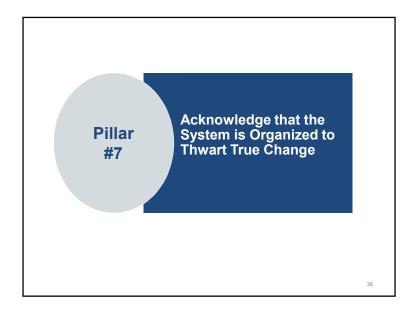








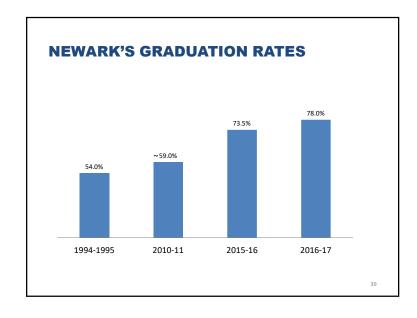


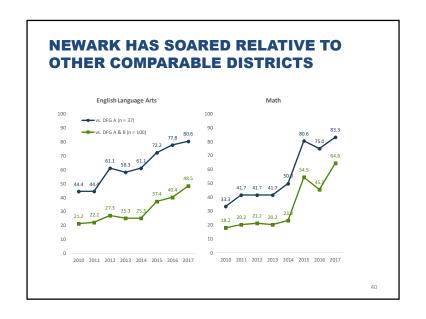


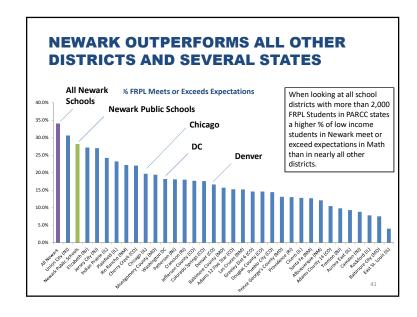


NEWARK: A CASE STUDY

- Between 2010 and 2017, graduation rate rose from ~59% to 78% the highest # in district history!
- African-American students are 300% more likely to attend a school that exceeds the state average
- Four-year college matriculation is at all-time high
- Test scores in reading and math up for three consecutive years exceeding EVERY comparable city and some entire states
