
Following up our conversation of December 14, 2016, when you informed me of your decision to terminate Tim Reidy's employment, and our subsequent conversation on December 20, 2016, notifying me you had let him go effective immediately, I must formally register my objections to this decision.

I would be remiss in my fiduciary duty if I let pass this unfortunate course of action without strenuously voicing my opposition to this ill conceived business decision. While acknowledging that the Will and our Working Agreement gives you great discretion in the operation of the businesses, these instruments cannot relieve me of my fiduciary duties.

It is clear to me that terminating Reidy's services places the continued success and viability of the businesses in jeopardy. Tim Reidy's extensive experience, seventeen years of institutional knowledge relative to the businesses, and his expertise in finance, will be hard, if not impossible to replicate. The fact that his employment was under contract legally limits the ability to fire him and hence exposes an already cash strapped estate to costly litigation and a potentially significant damages award. Finally, losing Reidy's solid and respected relationships with the estate's bankers, jeopardizes both existing and future financing.

As I have frequently expressed, we need to take the steps to raise cash in the estate. We need to do this expeditiously in a planned, purposeful and businesslike manner. If we do not do this, we risk the solvency of the estate, endanger the legacies of the beneficiaries and face the risk of personal liability as a result of our actions or inactions. The firing of Reidy has made this task even more difficult. Unless we can come to some prompt resolution of the problems raised by your actions, I may have to seek the advice of the Court relative to these issues.
